ORDINANCE NO. 2022-01

A FRANCHISE, granting to UPPER PENINSULA POWER COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right, power, and authority to lay, maintain and operate electric and fiber lines, poles and services on, along, across and under the highways, streets, alleys, bridges and other public places, and to conduct a local electric business in the Township of Grant, Keweenaw County, Michigan for a period of thirty years.

The Township of Grant ORDAINS:

- Section 1. Grant of Franchise. The Township of Grant, located in Keweenaw County, Michigan (the "Township") hereby grants to Upper Peninsula Power Company, its subsidiaries, successors, and assigns (the "Company") consent, permission, right and authority is hereby given to construct, lay, operate, maintain, use, and replace electric, fiber, and other communication lines, poles, cables, conduits, appliances, buildings and other necessary works, in the highways, streets, alleys and other public places in the Township and a non-exclusive franchise is hereby granted to the Company, its subsidiaries, successors, and assigns, to transact local business in the Township for the purposes of producing, storing, transmitting, selling, and distributing electricity into and through the Township and all other matters incidental thereto.
- **Section 2. Consideration**. In consideration of the rights, power and authority hereby granted, the Company shall faithfully perform all things required by the terms hereof.
- Section 3. Use of Streets and Other Public Places. The Company, its successors and assigns, shall not unnecessarily obstruct the passage of any of the highways, streets, alleys, or other public places within the Township and shall within a reasonable time after making an opening or excavations, repair the same and leave it in as good condition as before the opening or excavation was made. The Company, its successors and assigns shall use due care in exercising the privileges herein contained and shall be liable to the Township and to every owner of property abutting the Company's lines or other facilities, for all damages and costs arising from the negligence of the Company or its officers, agents, and servants.
- Section 4. Force Majeure. The Company shall not be liable for failure to furnish service as herein provided, or for any breach of the Company's obligations hereunder, if such failure or breach is caused by acts of God, labor troubles, riot, or any other causes or contingencies not reasonably within the control of the Company.
- Section 5. Hold Harmless. The Company shall at all times keep and save the Township free and harmless from all loss, costs and expense to which it may be subject by reason of the Company's negligent construction and negligent maintenance of the structures and equipment hereby authorized. If any action is commenced against the Township resulting from Company's negligent construction and maintenance, the Company shall, upon notice, defend the Township and save it free and harmless from all loss, cost and damage arising out of such negligent construction and maintenance.

- Section 6. Effective Date; Term of Franchise; Acceptance by the Company. This Franchise shall take effect the day following the date of publication thereof, which publication shall be made within thirty (30) days after the date of its adoption, and shall continue in effect for a period of thirty (30) years thereafter; provided, however, that when this Franchise shall become effective the Township Clerk shall deliver to the Company a certified copy of the Franchise accompanied by written evidence of publication thereof as required by law, and the Company shall, within sixty (60) days after receipt of the above documents, file with the Township Clerk its written acceptance of the conditions and provisions hereof.
- <u>Section 7.</u> <u>Franchise Not Exclusive.</u> The rights, power and authority granted by this Franchise are not exclusive, and nothing contained herein shall prevent the Township from granting other non-exclusive electric franchises.
- <u>Section 8.</u> <u>Franchise Revocable.</u> The franchise granted by this ordinance is subject to revocation upon sixty (60) days written notice by the party desiring such revocation.
- Section 9. Effect and Interpretation of Franchise. All other franchises, ordinances and resolutions, and parts thereof, which conflict with any of the terms of this Franchise are hereby rescinded, to the extent of such conflict. The catch line headings which precede each section of this Franchise are for convenience in reference only and shall not be taken into consideration in the construction or interpretation of any of the provisions of this Franchise.

Section 10. Successors and Assigns. The words "Upper Peninsula Power Company" and the "Company," wherever used herein, are intended and shall be held and construed to mean and include both Upper Peninsula Power Company and its subsidiaries, successors, and assigns, whether so expressed or not.

The Township of Grant ORDAINS:

Section 2. Consideration. In consideration of the rights, power and authority herek granted, the Company shall faithfully perform all things required by the terms hereof.

Section 3. Use of Streets and Other Public Places. The Company, its successo and assigns, shall not unnecessarily obstruct the passage of any of the highways, street alleys, or other public places within the Township and shall within a reasonable time aft making an opening or excavations, repair the same and leave it in as good condition as befo the opening or excavation was made. The Company, its successors and assigns shall use d care in exercising the privileges herein contained and shall be liable to the Township and every owner of property abutting the Company's lines or other facilities, for all damages a costs arising from the negligence of the Company or its officers, agents, and servants.

Section 4. Force Majeure. The Company shall not be liable for failure to furn service as herein provided, or for any breach of the Company's obligations hereunder, such failure or breach is caused by acts of God, labor troubles, riot, or any other causes contingencies not reasonably within the control of the Company.

Section 5. Hold Harmless. The Company shall at all times keep and save Township free and harmless from all loss, costs and expense to which it may be subject reason of the Company's negligent construction and negligent maintenance of the structu and equipment hereby authorized. If any action is commenced against the Township result from Company's negligent construction and maintenance, the Company shall, upon not defend the Township and save it free and harmless from all loss, cost and damage arising of such negligent construction and maintenance.

Franchise shall take effect the day following the date of publication thereof, which publicates shall be made within thirty (30) days after the date of its adoption, and shall continue in effor a period of thirty (30) years thereafter; provided, however, that when this Franchise secome effective the Township Clerk shall deliver to the Company a certified copy of Franchise accompanied by written evidence of publication thereof as required by law, the Company shall, within sixty (60) days after receipt of the above documents, file with Township Clerk its written acceptance of the conditions and provisions hereof.

Section 7. Franchise Not Exclusive. The rights, power and authority granted by Franchise are not exclusive, and nothing contained herein shall prevent the Township f granting other non-exclusive electric franchises.

Section 8. Franchise Revocable. The franchise granted by this ordinance is sulto revocation upon sixty (60) days written notice by the party desiring such revocation.

Section 9. Effect and Interpretation of Franchise. All other franchises, ordina and resolutions, and parts thereof, which conflict with any of the terms of this Franchise hereby rescinded, to the extent of such conflict. The catch line headings which precede section of this Franchise are for convenience in reference only and shall not be taken consideration in the construction or interpretation of any of the provisions of this Franchi

Section 10. Successors and Assigns. The words "Upper Peninsula Power Compand the "Company," wherever used herein, are intended and shall be held and construmean and include both Upper Peninsula Power Company and its subsidiaries, successors assigns, whether so expressed or not.
